

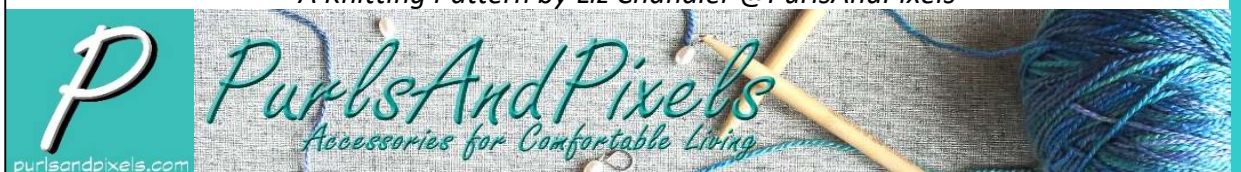


# Seed Stitch Washcloth

8-inch by 8-inch square

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## Size

8-inch by 8-inch square

## About this Pattern

This easy and quick washcloth pattern lets you practice the seed stitch pattern. Plus, using these washcloths feels so much better than store bought cloths. A bundle of these might make a nice baby shower or housewarming gift!



## Materials

- No. 7/4.50MM 29" circular needles or 14" straight needles (or size needed to obtain gauge)
- One 95-Yard (2 oz) skein Lily Sugar 'n Cream 100% Cotton Worsted Weight Yarn in your preferred color
- Tapestry needle

## Abbreviations

- k – knit
- p – purl
- \*\* - repeat the pattern between the asterisks

## Gauge

20 stitches and 30 rows in seed stitch = 4 inches

## Instructions: Seed Stitch Washcloth

(8" x 8" square)

Row 1: Cast on 40 stitches. Turn.

Row 2: \*k, p\* x 20 (40 stitches).

Row 3: \*p, k\* x 20 (40 stitches).

Repeat rows 2 and 3 **28 more times**  
(60 rows total) or until piece  
measures 8 inches square.

Bind off and weave in ends. Block if  
desired.
